Established by family, colleagues, students and friends for a project or scholarship in:

- Environmental engineering
- Climate change or related studies
- Sustainable energy
- Northern agriculture
- Local renewable resources

#4 CPR YUKON

- Training in CPR techniques

Training or projects relating to swimming or cross-country skiing.

#7 GOVERNMENT OF YUKON LEGACY FUND

Established by the Government of Yukon to:

- Assist students to further their studies
- Assist groups with Yukon projects

#8 TAMARA GUTTMAN MEMORIAL

A scholarship for studies in:

- Dance
- Social Work
- The Trades

#9 DEREEN HILDEBRAND

Established by family and friends for a scholarship or project for:

- A student attending art school
- A musician attending an arts festival in Canada
- Promotion of local arts skills enhancement
- Studio time for musicians

#10 THE HOUGEN FAMILY FUND

Scholarship and/or Project

For the scholarly study, preservation, and enhancement, of historical and cultural activities related to the life and progress of the Yukon. May be used as a scholarship, support of museum, archive or archaeology project. Established by family and friends to assist Yukon artists engaged in Yukon Arts programs.

#12 PATNODE FAMILY

Established by family and friends for studies in the arts, mining, geology or gemology.

One-year Yukon residency required.

#13 PAULA JOAN RIEHL MEMORIAL

Established by family and friends to assist F.H. Collins Grade 11 and Grade 12 students participating in secondary school international travel.

#14 JOHN & DORIS STENBRATEN

- A scholarship or project** relating to Yukon, or
- A scholarship** for studies in animal husbandry, or
- A scholarship** for a Yukoner writing or publishing a work related to Yukon.
- A project** relating to animal welfare in the Yukon

Projects and/or Scholarships – Continued

#15 ROD TAIT MEMORIAL

Established by family and friends for:

1. A scholarship for post-secondary studies in agriculture.
2. A Yukon project involving agriculture.
3. An individual pursuing skills that support agriculture.

#16 VERSLUCE BROTHERS

Established by bequest to benefit senior citizens.

#17 WHITEHORSE GLACIER BEARS SWIM CLUB

Established by the Club to assist current or past club members with post-secondary education.

#18 YUKON INDIAN HERITAGE

Established by donation from the original Yukon Indian Craft Shop for the educational needs of Indian children and to preserve the cultural heritage of Yukon Indian people.

#19 YUKON OUTDOORS CLUB

i) Scholarship - Yukon student in a recognized course of study in the field of wildlife management.

ii) Scholarship for studies which would qualify a student to work in a National/Territorial Park or historical preserve, or

iii) Any non-government historical research or project relating directly to the Chilkoot trail, or

SCHOLARSHIPS ONLY

#20 THE ALANO CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

For Yukon students in social work, clinical research or counselling related to addictions or the effects of alcohol.

#21 ALBERTA CENTENNIAL PROGRAM

Scholarships established by the Province of Alberta for Yukon graduates in their first year of post-secondary studies in any field and attending an eligible Canadian institution for a duration of eight weeks or more to further their education in a certificate, diploma, under-graduate degree, or trades in-school training. *One-year Yukon residency required. Two letters of recommendation required.*

#22 FAY ANTHONY

A **Scholarship** for Yukon students studying:

1. Health Sciences; including sports fitness
2. Medical Technologies: X-Ray technician, ultrasound, radiology, etc.
3. Medical Studies: Nursing or physician training

#23 THOMAS J. BLACK

To support a Porter Creek School graduate in any year and any program of post-graduate studies.

#24 JOAN BILTON

A **scholarship** for a student who has graduated from a Dawson City senior secondary school or Dawson City Campus of Yukon College and has been accepted at an accredited post-secondary institution.

#25 GEOFFREY BRADSHAW MEMORIAL

Established by family and friends.

To be eligible, the candidate must be a Canadian citizen enrolled in a Canadian university in the first or second year of a graduate Geology program and must be working on a thesis with a Yukon field component. An individual can be awarded the scholarship more than once. Priority is given to applicants who have not previously received the scholarship.

#26 GLADYS BRUCE

A **scholarship** for post-secondary studies in biology or geology.

#27 ARCHIE BRUCE

A **scholarship** to further the achievement of Yukon students in the fields of science and engineering.

#28 BOREAL ALTERNATE ENERGY CENTRE

A **scholarship** in post-secondary studies in alternate energy.

#29 G.I. AND MARTHA CAMERON

A **scholarship** for a Yukon born resident who wishes to pursue post-secondary training in nursing or the humanity disciplines. *A letter is to accompany the application setting out why the applicant has chosen their career path.*

#30 ROBERT & JEAN CAMPBELL

A **scholarship** for Atlin or Yukon persons studying in the field of business management or for educational studies which will advance business skills.

#31 BRIAN CAMPION

A **scholarship** to assist a Yukon student to further their studies in law.

#32 COMMISSION SCOLAIRE FRANCOPHONE DU YUKON #23

A **bursary** to support Yukon French First Language students.

#33 MARVIN CRAWFORD

A **scholarship** for an established Yukon resident, with demonstrated mechanical abilities, furthering skills in refrigeration/air conditioning, or other trades.

#34 DAWSON DISTRICT RENEWABLE RESOURCES COUNCIL

A **scholarship** to assist Dawson City students pursuing post-secondary studies in renewable resources related fields. *Two letters of reference required.*

#35 ANNE & KONRAD DOMES

A **scholarship** for post-secondary Yukon students enrolled in architecture or drafting. *Three-years Yukon residency required.*

#36 DEBRA DUNGEY

A **scholarship** for women students who are a resident of Yukon pursuing studies in nursing or social work.

#37 MARK & HEINZ EICHHORN

A **scholarship** for students from (1) Mayo or (2) Yukon enrolled in renewable resources, mechanics, or the trades.

#38 FLO WHYARD-HOLLAND AMERICA LINE – WESTOURS FUND

A **scholarship** for a women studying journalism.

#39 HARRY JOHANNES

A **scholarship** to an under graduate or graduate student enrolled in engineering sciences, with emphasis on geology.

#40 MARILYN KING

A **scholarship** for a Yukon resident pursuing post-secondary studies in business related courses and accounting. Demonstrated financial need. Good grades.

Five-year Yukon residency required.

#41 KLONDIKE PLACER MINERS' ASSOC.

Indian River Scholarship

Open to members of the KPMA and their immediate family.

- Yukon graduate enrolled in post secondary studies.
- A letter of recommendation from any professional person aware of your career goals
- A brief essay on placer mining what it means and what it has done for you.

#42 PATRICIA KOHLER

To provide a scholarship for a young person to receive extra training in dance. *Three-years Yukon residency and a reference from your dance teacher.*

#43 RUTH & GORDON McINTYRE

A **scholarship** for a post-secondary Yukon student pursuing studies in Education.

#44 BEA & GEORGE McLEOD

For:

- Studies to obtain a commercial pilot's license
- Studies for a license in aircraft maintenance engineering
- Any other studies related to aviation endeavours

One-year Yukon residency required.

#45 JAMES W. MURDOCH

A **scholarship** for a deserving Yukon resident pursuing studies in music, drama, or other fine arts.

#46 GORDON NEWMAN RECREATION

A **scholarship** to assist a Yukon student in post-secondary recreation studies. *One-year Yukon residency required.*

#47 HERMAN PETERSON

Established by his widow for a Yukon post-secondary student engaged in any of the trades or technical programs.

#48 J. L. PHELPS

Established by the Yukon Electrical Company Ltd

A **scholarship** for post-secondary Yukon students studying engineering or business management.

#49 GARRY PHILLIPS

A **scholarship** for studies or training in:

- Any Apprenticeship Trade
- R.V. Technician
- Home Care
- Nursing

Scholarships Only – Continued

#50 THE PORTER CREEK CITIZENS' ASSOC.

Established to assist graduates of Porter Creek Secondary who have been a resident of Porter Creek for a minimum of two years at the time they complete their last year of high school. Proof of residency must be submitted in the form of a letter from the School Principal.

Candidates will be evaluated on the following attributes:

- Good Citizenship: Participation in school and community affairs.*
- Good Character: Interpersonal relationships, attitudes to fellow students and teachers and personal traits.*
- Conduct: Punctuality/attendance/behaviour/ work habits/attitude.*

Two letters of reference are required.

#51 GARY REYNOLDS

Established by family and friends for a Yukon student in the 2nd to 5th year in any program of study.

#52 ROTARY CLUB OF WHITEHORSE

Rotary Music Festival and the Harvey Memorial Scholarship to provide support and enhance the development of Yukon residents furthering their studies in the performing arts. *Applicants must be participants in the Rotary Music Festival in the year of application.*

#53 SCHMIDT FAMILY

Established by Ballarat Mines and the family in memory of Marion & Harold Schmidt and their son Craig Anthony, a **scholarship** for women studying law or social services.

#54 JOAN SHAXON

A **scholarship** to assist a Yukon student studying in fine arts, art history, museum studies, or arts administration.

#55 BEN SHEARDOWN

A **scholarship** for a Yukon post-secondary student studying renewable resources or the environment.

#56 STUART/SIM NORTHERN EDUCATION

A **scholarship** for studies in any area which would be of benefit to the development of northern communities, including but not limited to, the areas of Justice; the environment; alternate dispute resolution; aboriginal law.

#57 CHARLES DRURY TAYLOR

A **scholarship** for a student studying medicine.

#58 EDITH & VICTOR THOMAS

A **scholarship** to assist a Yukon student in the pursuit of musical career studies.

#59 JOAN VEINOTT

A **scholarship** for a Yukon student studying social sciences.

#60 VILLAGE OF MAYO HERITAGE FUND

A scholarship to support post-secondary education for Mayo-area students.

Applicants to provide a proposal of their education plans and a short essay on how their plans will benefit the community.

Established by bequest for Yukon students pursuing post-secondary studies in teaching and/or the environment.

#62 MATTHEW WEBSTER

Established by family and friends to support a Yukon resident pursuing post-secondary studies in technical, construction design, and/or apprenticeship training.

#63 CÄCILIE WIGEN

Established by her husband to support the local women's shelter or the local animal shelter. Awarded annually.

#64 SHIRLEY WILLIAMS

A **scholarship** to a Yukon resident studying education.

#65 ROBERT WILSON

Established by bequest to provide a scholarship for a Yukon student enrolled full-time in any of the trades or technical programs.

#66 WHITEHORSE BUSINESS & PROFESSIONAL WOMEN'S CLUB BURSARY

Awarded to a girl or woman for furthering her education at any recognized educational institution. Demonstrated financial need. *Two-years Yukon residency required.*

#67 WHITEHORSE COPPER MINES

A **scholarship** for a student completing a minimum of two years in mining-related studies.

#68 YUKON ANNIVERSARIES COMMISSION

A **Scholarship** for post-secondary students pursuing tourism related studies.

#69 YUKON COLLEGE ENDOWMENT

Established by the Board and other friends of the College to support Yukon College students pursuing studies in any program.

#70 Y.W.C.A. of YUKON

A **scholarship** for women 25 years of age or over requiring assistance to further their education. *Five-years Yukon residency required.*

PROJECTS ONLY

#71 DES DUNCAN

Funding for projects or group training programs related to cross-country skiing in Yukon.

#72 TED FESER ENDOWMENT

Established by the Grey Mountain Lions Club to promote Special Olympics programs.

#73 IRA "SLIM" FOSTER

Established for the Yukon Women's Transition Home Society for the care of abused children. Awarded annually.

Projects Only – Continued

#74 GEORGE GREEN LEGACY

Established for Yukon charities committed to ensuring that people throughout the Yukon are provided with accommodations and supports they need to reach their full potential.

#75 HERITAGE NORTH

For research or fieldwork in natural and/or cultural history, within the Yukon and Chilkoot Trail with preference to national parks and national historic sites.

#76 KLONDIKE DEFENCE FORCE

For research or studies in Yukon history.

#77 MAYO HISTORICAL SOCIETY

The recipient may be an individual or group interested in a project related to the Mayo district. The project must contribute significantly to the information available on the Mayo district. Art projects are included in this definition.

#78 ROY MINTER

Funds to be granted to worthy applicants for the scholarly research and authorship of Yukon History.

#79 JAN MONTGOMERY

Funds are to be used for any worthy project which contributes to the aesthetic enhancement of any properties owned or maintained by the City of Whitehorse. *10% of the grant will be held over to cover two years of project maintenance. Recipients may apply for holdback funds in May of the next two years on project completion.*

#80 RICK & MAUREEN NIELSEN ACTION CANADA - Northern Youth Research Award

For a community-based research project activity or component of a research project, which demonstrates research and leadership skills. Research to be focused on climate change impacts and adaptation of the health and well-being of Northern communities. Research can be based upon natural, traditional, or social science topics and should actively involve the community.

#81 NORTHERN WRITERS CIRCLE

To promote Yukon writers. Five consecutive years Yukon residency. Previously published.

#82 TANNER FAMILY

For projects in Yukon to ensure the protection of the natural environment of Yukon for future generations. *Five years Yukon residency required. Work to be done in Yukon.*

#83 WHITEHORSE BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB PROJECT YOUTH AWARDS

Funds for Whitehorse projects which serve the needs of children between the ages of 7 to 14 years. Such projects may be, but are not limited to, the following:

- a. Group travel to a special event.
- b. Development in the arts.
- c. Play ground development.
- d. A one-time capital item for a youth centre.
- e. A conference for children.
- f. Travel or fee assistance for children to attend a summer camp or special educational program.

Priority: volunteer/non-profit groups/individuals.

#84 YUKON MEDICAL ASSOCIATION

Established to assist the Yukon Medical Association with the annual expenses of their medical education update weekend. Awarded annually.

#85 YUKON SCOUT COUNCIL

Established by the Council to assist Yukon scouting youth and registered Yukon scouter adults to attend Canadian jamborees and world jamborees.

#86 YUKON SENATOR'S ASSISTANCE

Assistance for Yukon senior secondary students to attend the Forum for Young Canadians in Ottawa.

For an aboriginal student enrolled in a degree program, undergrad or postgrad, in any field of study.
Three year Yukon residency required.

#3a Whitehorse Lions Club

i. Bursary (\$1,000)

To assist a Grade 12 Yukon graduate attending post-secondary education.

ii. John Flesher Flying Scholarship (\$1,000)

For youth, under 21, to assist with flying or ground school.
