STORY: Edith (1910 - 2004) (“the Flying Finn”) was born in Finland and came to Canada in 1926. In 1935 she came to the Yukon and worked in Carcross for the Phelps family. She then went to Dawson City, and in 1942 moved to Whitehorse to work at the Whitehorse Inn for TC Richards. She had various jobs with Pan American and the Armed Forces during the construction of the Alaska Highway.
