Charles Drury Taylor grew up in Whitehorse and worked for the family business, Taylor & Drury, established by his father Issac Taylor and William S. Drury.

Betty and Charlie met in Mayo and married in 1936. They moved to Whitehorse in 1942 so Charlie could manage the family business.

They were active, engaged community members, honoured with the Commissioner's Award and later Mr. and Mrs. Yukon.
