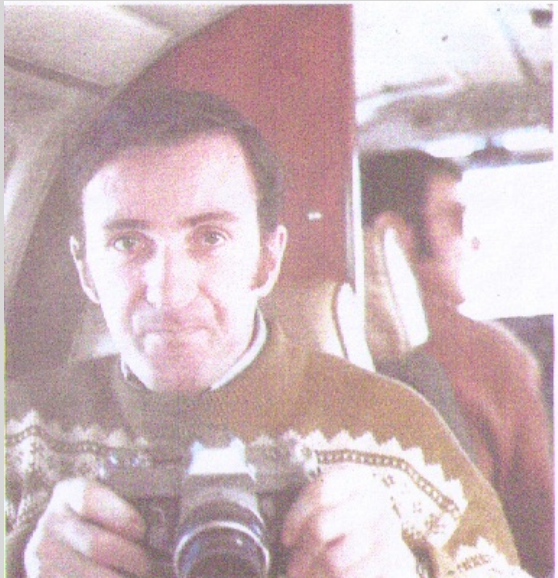


KENNETH ROBERT JONES
