STORY: The Boreal Alternate Energy Fund was established in honour of Dr. Douglas Bennell Craig (1933 - 2005). Dr. Craig moved with his family to the Yukon in 1969 to work as Regional Geologist with the Federal Dept. of Indian and Northern Affairs.

Dr. Craig taught geology classes at the Whitehorse Correctional Centre, Whitehorse Vocational School, the Yukon Chamber of Mines, and Carcross Community School. This led to teaching at FH Collins Secondary School and the newly-formed Yukon College.

Dr. Craig pursued his own research on sustainable energy and greenhouse gas reduction, co-founding Boreal Alternative Energy and leading the project to get wind turbines installed on Haeckel Hill. Dr. Craig provided expertise for land reclamation and water quality across the territory.
